On July 20, 2000, Northern Kentucky Water District ("Northern Kentucky") applied for approval of 3 hours of commissioner training in accordance with KRS 74.020(7). Northern Kentucky requested that it be granted 3 training hours for attending the North Central Kentucky Water and Wastewater Operators Association's training session held on July 27, 2000.

The Commission finds that the Operator Safety and Valve Operation and Maintenance sessions should each be approved for one hour commissioner training. One hour of the program will consist of a tour of Northern Kentucky's new water quality laboratory. The Commission finds that this session should not be included as part of the water commissioner training program. Each commissioner of Northern Kentucky should already be familiar with the district's water quality laboratory.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Northern Kentucky's commissioners shall receive one hour of credit for attending the operator safety session and one hour of credit for attending the valve operation and maintenance session. The one hour credit for the tour of Northern Kentucky's water quality laboratory does not meet the qualifications for approval for commissioner training pursuant to KRS 74.020(7) and is hereby denied.
