O R D E R

On October 9, 2000, Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation (“Jackson Energy”) applied to the Commission for authority to adjust its rates. In its filing, Jackson Energy requested permission to deviate from the requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(s).

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(s), requires the submission of the applicant’s Securities and Exchange Commission’s annual report for the most recent 2 years, Form 10-Ks and any Form 8-Ks issued within the past 2 years, and Form 10-Qs issued during the past six quarters updated as current information becomes available.

Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information filed therein is sufficient to enable the Commission to review adequately Jackson Energy’s filing and that good cause exists to grant the requested deviation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jackson Energy’s request for permission to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(s), is granted.
