COMMISSION STAFF INFORMATION REQUEST

Pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Commission Staff requests that Smithland Hydroelectric Partners, Ltd. (“Smithland”) and Cannelton Hydroelectric Project, Ltd. (“Cannelton”) file the original and 5 copies of the following information with the Commission by January 17, 2001, with a copy to all parties of record. Each copy of the information requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure its legibility.

1. Provide the name, title, and business address of each officer of Smithland.
2. Provide an organizational chart which shows the name, business address, and chain of ownership for each individual, partnership, or corporation which directly or indirectly owns an interest in Smithland.

a. For each partnership listed, provide the name and business address of each member.


b. For each corporation listed, provide the approximate number of shareholders. If there are 20 or fewer shareholders, provide the name and business address of each shareholder.

3. If any of the entities identified in response to Question No. 1 or 2 are regulated as utilities, either in Kentucky or elsewhere, provide the name of the jurisdiction where regulated and a description of the regulated service being provided.

4. Has a federal license or permit been issued for the construction of a hydroelectric facility at Smithland? If yes, provide the name of the license or permit holder, the date of issuance, and the date, if any, by which construction must be commenced or completed to avoid loss or termination of the license or permit.

5. Provide an affidavit signed by an officer of Smithland, verifying the accuracy of the facts set forth in the pending Commission application.

6. Provide responses to Question Nos. 1-5 for Cannelton.
