O R D E R

On July 16, 2001, the Commission entered an Order approving the proposal of United Way of Kentucky to assign the 211 abbreviated dialing code for access to community information referral services to United Way of Kentucky and its affiliate organization. The 211 services in the portion of the Commonwealth served by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") will be provided pursuant to a tariff, which the Commission had suspended on January 11, 2001. BellSouth extended the period for Commission review of the 211 tariff to July 30, 2001.

The Commission's July 16, 2001 Order inadvertently failed to reflect that BellSouth's tariff regarding 211 service was approved effective the day of the Order. The decisions reached in that July 16, 2001 Order necessarily include approval of the tariff.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, to be entered nunc pro tunc, that the tariff proposed by BellSouth for 211 service is approved effective July 16, 2001.
