ORDER

On April 12, 1993, in Case No. 92-326, the Commission approved certain adjusted rates for Equitable Gas Company, a division of Equitable Resources, Inc. ("Equitable"), and provided for their further adjustment on a quarterly basis in accordance with Equitable's gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On April 2, 2001, Equitable filed its GCA to be effective May 1, 2001 through July 31, 2001.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Equitable's notice of April 2, 2001 proposes revised rates designed to pass on expected decreased wholesale gas costs to its customers. Equitable's proposed expected gas cost ("EGC") is \$9.0921 per Mcf, which includes a surcharge component of 80.54 cents per Mcf relating to the settlement of Kentucky West Virginia Gas Company Docket No. TQ 89-1-46-000, et al. before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. This EGC represents a decrease of \$1.4727 per Mcf from the current EGC of \$10.5648.
- 2. Equitable's notice of April 2, 2001 set out a current quarter actual adjustment ("AA") of \$1.4766 per Mcf to collect under-recovered gas cost from

November and December 2000 and January 2001. Equitable's total AA of \$2.0679 per

Mcf reflects the current under-recovery as well as over- and under-recoveries from

previous quarters, and represents a \$1.7364 per Mcf increase from the previous total

AA.

3. Equitable's notice set out a current guarter balancing adjustment ("BA") of

(.17) cent per Mcf. Equitable's total BA is (1.3) cents per Mcf, and represents a .02 cent

per Mcf decrease from the previous total BA.

4. These adjustments produce a revised gas cost recovery ("GCR") rate of

\$11.1470 per Mcf, 26.35 cents per Mcf more than its prior GCR rate of \$10.8835.

5. The rate adjustment in the Appendix to this Order is fair, just, and

reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be effective for final meter readings on

and after May 1, 2001.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and

are effective for final meter readings on and after May 1, 2001.

2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Equitable shall file with this

Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
