O R D E R

On September 16, 1998, the Commission granted a motion by Jackson Energy Cooperative, then called Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, to suspend the procedural schedule in these proceedings and to hold the case in abeyance pending further orders. The order was based on a finding that this case involved issues similar to those in *Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation vs. Public Service Commission*, No. 96-CI-001130, in the Franklin Circuit Court. Those issues were resolved by the Court of Appeals whose decision became final on August 15, 2001, when the Supreme Court denied discretionary review of the case. There being no other reason to continue to hold this case in abeyance, and the Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. A formal hearing in this matter is scheduled for November 1, 2001, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

2. Within 20 days from the date of this Order the party may, by written motion, request an informal conference with the Commission Staff to consider any matter which would aid the handling or disposition of this proceeding.
