#### ORDER

On December 27, 1999, in Case No. 99-176, the Commission approved certain adjusted rates for Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with its gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On February 28, 2001, Delta filed its GCA to be effective from April 1, 2001 to April 30, 2001.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Delta's notice proposes revised rates designed to pass on its expected increased wholesale gas costs to its customers. Delta's proposed expected gas cost ("EGC") is \$6.7641 per Mcf, excluding take-or-pay billings. The EGC is \$1.1934 per Mcf more than the previous EGC of \$5.5707.
- 2. Delta's notice sets out no current refund adjustment ("RA"). The total RA of .96 cent per Mcf includes refund adjustments from prior quarters.
- 3. Delta's notice sets out no current actual adjustment ("AA"). The total AA of 18.72 cents per Mcf reflects over and under-collections from previous quarters.

4. Delta's notice sets out a balance adjustment ("BA") of (.18) cent per Mcf to

return \$3,175 of net over-collections which occurred as a result of previous adjustments.

5. These adjustments produce a gas cost recovery rate ("GCR") of \$6.9399

per Mcf, \$1.1934 per Mcf more than the previous GCR of \$5.7465.

6. The rate adjustment in the Appendix to this Order is fair, just, and

reasonable, in the public interest, and should be approved for final meter readings on

and after April 1, 2001.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and

are effective for final meter readings on and after April 1, 2001.

2. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Delta shall file with this

Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
