<u>O R D E R</u>

On October 26, 2000, Crown Communication Inc. and NPCR, Inc. (collectively "Applicants") filed an application requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a wireless telecommunications facility at 1640 Old Madisonville Road, Henderson, Henderson County, Kentucky. On November 22, 2000, the Commission received a letter from Ernest L. Green ("Invervenor") requesting full intervention in this case. The Commission granted Intervenor's motion by Order dated December 1, 2000.

On May 31, 2001, the Applicants filed a Notice of First Amendment of Application. This notice stated that the Applicants reviewed an alternative site proposed by Intervenor and determined that the site met its requirements and needs for a cellular tower location. Through this amendment, the Applicants proposed to construct the tower at the alternate site proposed by Intervenor.

The Commission has not yet received a letter or other document from Intervenor regarding his position on this new location. Given that Intervenor proposed this new site, the Commission finds that he should, within 10 days of the date of this Order, state in writing his intent to appear at a hearing in opposition to the proposed facility. If no statement of intent to appear at the hearing and present evidence against the proposed facility is received by that date, this matter shall stand submitted to the Commission for a decision based on the written record without further Orders herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. If the Intervenor, Ernest L. Green, desires a hearing in this matter, he shall, within 10 days of this Order, so notify the Commission in writing, with a copy to all parties of record, of his request for a hearing of this matter.

2. Should the Commission receive no such notification, this matter shall stand submitted for Commission decision based upon the record.
