ORDER

Pursuant to Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission on June 11, 2001 established this case to review and evaluate the operation of the fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of American Electric Power company ("AEP") for the 6 months ended April 30, 2001.

As part of this review, AEP, pursuant to Commission Order, submitted certain information concerning its compliance with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:056. A public hearing was held on September 4, 2001.

The Commission has previously established AEP's base fuel cost at 11.45 mills per Kwh.¹ A review of AEP's monthly fuel clause filings shows that the actual fuel cost incurred for the 6-month period under review ranged from a low of 10.17 mills in November 2000 to a high of 10.71 mills in January 2001, with a 6-month average of 10.47 mills.

During the course of this proceeding, AEP acknowledged that it overstated its

fuel costs for the months of November 2000 and March 2001 by \$231,056 by failing to

properly report purchases made during periods of forced outages. AEP corrected these

errors by making an adjustment to reduce fuel costs by \$231,056 in its August 2001

FAC report filed with the Commission.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise

sufficiently advised, finds that, other than the incorrect reporting of fuel costs in the

months of November 2000 and March 2001 that were subsequently identified and

corrected as described in the preceding paragraph, there is no evidence of improper

calculation or application of AEP's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges and credits billed by AEP

through its FAC for the period November 1, 2000 to April 30, 2001 are approved.
