O R D E R

This matter arises upon the motions for full intervention of Carolyn Lawson, Hoyt and Katrenia Caddell, Mike Lanham, Edith and Harris Brewer, Mr. and Mrs. Harrison Middleton, Wood and Rosalie Hensley, Larry G. Gray, Jason and Christina Boggs, Michael and Jane White, and Marquette Rae (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Petitioners"). It appears to the Commission that such interventions are likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. Therefore, Petitioners' motions to intervene should be granted.

On December 28, 2000, the Commission received a letter from Meek Massengill requesting intervention in this case. However, Mr. Massengill failed to provide his address. Any party wishing to intervene must include in his or her motion a current address. 807 KAR 5:001.

The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The motions of Petitioners to intervene are granted.

2. Each Petitioner shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.


3. Should any Petitioner file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, said Petitioner shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.

4. Meek Massengill's motion to intervene is denied.
