O R D E R

On March 1, 2001, the city of Kevil applied for authority to acquire the Bandana Water District. KRS 278.020(5) provides that the Commission shall act upon such applications within 60 days of their filing unless the Commission and the acquirer agree to a later date.

The city of Kevil, by and through its Mayor, Charles Burnley, has agreed to extend by 30 days the statutory period for Commission review and action. The city of Kevil and Bandana also requested an extension in which to respond to Commission Staff's data request. Finding these extensions to be reasonable, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The city of Kevil's application for authority to acquire the Bandana Water District is continued for a period not to exceed 30 days from the statutory deadline.
2. The city of Kevil and Bandana Water District shall have until May 1, 2001 in which to respond to data requests propounded by Commission Staff.
