O R D E R

U. S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties, Kentucky (“U.S. 60”) has filed for Commission approval a contract with Tim Hagen (“Applicant”) for the extension of distribution lines to serve the Orchard Acres Subdivision. In exchange for U.S. 60’s contribution toward the construction costs of the project, the Applicant has agreed to waive his right to a refund pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11.¹ Therefore, the proposed contract differs from the provisions of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11. In addition, U.S. 60 cannot at this time determine the amount it will contribute toward the project.² Accordingly, the Commission establishes this case to review the contract and determine whether a deviation is appropriate.

Based on the foregoing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. This case is established to review and determine the reasonableness of the proposed contract.

2. U.S. 60 shall furnish information regarding its proposed contribution as soon as the project is bid and a bid is accepted.
