<u>ORDER</u>

On June 25, 2001, Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District ("Jessamine-South Elkhorn") filed a tariff revision wherein it proposed to add a new rule to furnish free water to extinguish fires. Jessamine-South Elkhorn proposed that the tariff revision become effective on and after June 27, 2001. KRS 278.180(1) provides that a utility may make no change in its rates except upon 30 days' notice to the Commission and as Jessamine-South Elkhorn has not provided the required 30-day notice, its proposed tariff revision cannot become effective prior to July 25, 2001.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further investigation is needed to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff revision.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff filing of Jessamine-South Elkhorn is suspended for 5 months from July 25, 2001 up to and including December 24, 2001.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
