2. Will any construction be required to carry out the terms and conditions of this contract? If so, describe individually each project, its location, cost, estimated date of beginning construction, and estimated finish date.

3. Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 16, requires periodic tests of all water meters. According to paragraph 8 of the contract, the meters shall be tested at least once every 5-year period. Explain why this test period is used rather than the period prescribed by 807 KAR 5:066, Section 16.
