O R D E R

The Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that:


1. The rate unbundling studies prepared by Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") shall be reviewed in this docket.
2. The parties to this case shall include LG&E, KU, the Attorney General's Office, Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, and Metro Human Needs Alliance and People Organized and Working for Energy Reform.
3. LG&E and KU shall file, within 10 days of the date of this Order, one copy of their respective rate unbundling studies with a notice to parties of record certifying the date of filing.
4. The procedural schedule attached hereto as Appendix A shall be followed in this case. Except as otherwise specified, all filings shall include an original and 10 copies.

5. Unless an informal conference or hearing is requested in accordance with the procedural schedule, this case shall stand submitted for a decision based on the evidence of record following the authorized discovery.
