O R D E R

In 1991 the Commission established end-user billing requirements for local exchange carriers ("LECs") in this proceeding. Due to changes in telecommunications regulations and technology, the Commission will revisit those requirements.

This day, in Case No. 2002-00310, the Commission establishes a new administrative proceeding to examine customer billing requirements for all telecommunications carriers rendering end-user bills. Because this proceeding was conducted prior to key alterations in telecommunications technology and regulation, and because the Commission intends to consider other billing issues that are not at issue herein, a new proceeding is established. Accordingly, the Commission finds that procedures established in this case may be altered by the investigation to be conducted in Case No. 2002-00310 and this docket is hereby closed.
