ORDER

It appears from the record that an informal conference should be conducted prior to the scheduling of any hearing in this matter. The Intervenors have posed various questions that can be addressed, and perhaps resolved, by a conference. But, since the tower site and the Intervenors homes are located in Livingston County, Kentucky, holding a conference at the Commission's offices in Frankfort would be an undue burden on the Intervenors because of the traveling distance from home to Frankfort.

The Commission finds that a telephonic conference should be conducted unless the Intervenors object.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A telephonic informal conference is scheduled between Commission Staff, Applicants, and Intervenors on February 20, 2002 at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, (9:00 a.m., Central Standard Time). 2. The Intervenors and Applicants shall, within 10 days of the date of this Order, notify Commission Staff and the Applicants in writing if

a. the telephonic conference is acceptable, and

b. the telephone number where the Intervenors can be reached to conduct the conference on the date and time set.

3. If the Intervenors fail to respond to this Order, the conference shall be cancelled and a public hearing place, date, and time shall be set as soon as possible.

4. If the telephonic conference is acceptable to the parties, Commission Staff shall make appropriate arrangements to initiate the telephone calls described herein.
