O R D E R

On February 8, 2002, Cinergy Communications Company ("Cinergy") filed a motion to adjust the current procedural schedule in the manner proposed in its motion and to extend the due date for ruling on the issues in arbitration to May 31, 2002. It appearing that BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ( BellSouth ) has no objection to the adjustment, and the Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the procedural Order previously established herein be amended as follows:

1. A formal hearing in this matter is scheduled for April 10, 2002 at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission s offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

2. Responses to Data Requests served on or before February 7, 2002 shall be due February 21, 2002. Objections to data requests shall be filed within 10 days of service and shall state with specificity the grounds relied upon. No data requests may be served after February 7, 2002, except by leave of the Commission.

3. Relevant cost studies, if any, regarding each item in dispute, including workpapers, and any other documents and information necessary to resolve outstanding issues, shall be filed by March 4, 2002.

4. Direct Testimony shall be filed by March 7, 2002 and Rebuttal Testimony, if any, shall be filed by March 21, 2002. Testimony at the hearing shall be limited to cross-examination and redirect examination.

5. Any agreed-upon portions of the parties contract that have not already been filed shall be filed by March 21, 2002.

6. Each party shall submit, in contract form, its best and final offer on each disputed issue no later than March 21, 2002.

7. Post-Hearing Briefs shall be filed by May 1, 2002.

8. The provisions of the current procedural schedule that are not inconsistent with this Order shall remain in full force and effect.
