ORDER

On December 3, 2001, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company (ULH&P) filed a proposed Generation Support Services (GSS) tariff, to be offered to customers having their own source of electric generation. By Order dated December 27, 2001, the tariff was suspended for the purpose of further review to determine its reasonableness. An informal conference attended by representatives of ULH&P, the Office of the Attorney General (AG), and Commission Staff (Staff) was held January 15, 2002 at the Commission's offices to discuss various provisions within the tariff and evaluate whether the need for revisions to the tariff could be determined. As agreed at the informal conference, ULH&P revised the proposed GSS tariff to address issues raised concerning the applicability of the tariff, the customers that might benefit from the tariff, and the tariff's relationship to ULH&P's existing Real Time Pricing tariff', Rate RTP-M. On January 28, 2002, ULH&P submitted the revised GSS tariff along with its publication System Protection Requirements and Guidelines for Connection and Parallel Operation of Non-Utility Generators, which Staff had requested be filed.

Having considered the issues raised in the informal conference and the changes reflected in ULH&P's revised GSS tariff, the Commission finds that the revised tariff is reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that ULH&P's Rider GSS tariff, as revised in its January 28, 2002 filing, is approved effective with the date of this Order.
