ORDER

On October 21, 2002, the Commission entered an Order denying the city of Russellville, Kentucky's (Russellville) proposed wholesale water service rate to North Logan Water District and East Logan Water District, Inc., and established a lower rate for such service. In establishing this rate, we failed to consider that Russellville had been assessing the proposed rate subject to refund since July 3, 2002.¹ As Russellville's authority to change the proposed rate from July 3, 2002 to October 21, 2002 was conditioned upon the refund of any portion of the proposed rate found excessive, we find that the effective date of the approved wholesale rate should have been July 3, 2002. Our Order of October 21, 2002 should be modified accordingly.

Therefore, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that Ordering Paragraph 2 of the Order of October 21, 2002 is stricken and replaced with the following:

2. The rate of \$2.24 per 1,000 gallons of water is approved for water service rendered by Russellville to the Logan Districts on and after July 3, 2002. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Russellville shall refund to the Logan Districts any rate in excess of the approved rate that is assessed and collected for water service provided between July 3, 2002 and the date of this Order.
