## ORDER

On March 25, 2002, Elam Utility Company, Inc. (Elam) submitted revisions to its general schedule of rates and conditions of service. On April 3, 2002, the Secretary of the Commission notified Elam that its filing was rejected because of deficiencies listed in the notification. Elam was granted two extensions of time to submit the information necessary to cure the deficiencies. The last extension, which was granted on August 13, 2002, allowed Elam until August 28, 2002 to file the information, but the Commission advised the company that the case would be dismissed if the information was not submitted by that date. Elam has not filed the information necessary to cure the filing deficiencies.

The Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is dismissed without prejudice.
