ORDER

Motions have been filed by city of Taylor Mill (Taylor Mill) and Bullock Pen Water District (BPWD), intervenors, for a 30-day extension of time to propound a supplemental information request to Northern Kentucky Water District (NKWD). The movants state in support of their motion that they have recently employed an engineer to review NKWD s application and that additional time is needed for the engineer to complete his analysis and for the movants to prepare an information request. NKWD filed a response in opposition stating that the procedural schedule established by the Commission in this proceeding provided adequate opportunity for the movants to employ a consultant and to review the application without delaying the proceeding and that the intervenors will have an opportunity at the hearing to ask any questions they may have about NKWD s application.

After consideration of the motions and NKWD's response, the Commission finds that the motions for extension should be denied. The Commission finds that BPWD and Taylor Mill were granted intervention on May 22, 2002 and July 10, 2002 respectively and that the procedural schedule as amended by the Commission on August 15, 2002

provided sufficient time for the movants to review and propound information requests. The Commission further finds that the movants will have an opportunity to cross-examine NKWD at the hearing in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motions of Taylor Mill and BPWD are denied.
