<u>ORDER</u>

By Order dated May 21, 2002, the Commission notified the telecommunication carriers whose names appeared in an appendix attached thereto that, for failing to pay their annual assessments for the periods shown in the appendix, their authorization to provide service in this state would be revoked, their tariffs removed from Commission files, and their names stricken from the list of active utilities, unless they were able to show cause within 30 days why such action should not be taken. Aero Communications, LLC was listed in the appendix as being delinquent in the payment of its assessment for the July 1, 2001--June 30, 2002 fiscal year.

On August 21, 2002, in accordance with the May 21, 2002 Order, the Commission revoked the authority of Aero Communications, LLC to operate in Kentucky. Subsequently, it was determined that Aero Communications, LLC had been erroneously billed twice for the 2001-2002 annual assessment, and that one of the bills had been paid. The operating authority of Aero Communications, LLC should, therefore, be reactivated and its tariffs reinstated effective August 21, 2002.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Aero Communications, LLCs operating authority in Kentucky as a telecommunications carrier is hereby reactivated and its tariffs reinstated effective August 21, 2002.

2. As soon as possible, Aero Communications, LLC shall file copies of its tariffs, setting forth the rates and conditions of service that were in effect on August 21, 2002.
