O R D E R

By Order dated May 21, 2002, the Commission notified the telecommunication carriers whose names appeared in an appendix attached thereto that, for failing to pay their annual assessments for the periods shown in the appendix, their authorization to provide service in this state would be revoked, their tariffs removed from Commission files, and their names stricken from the list of active utilities, unless they were able to show cause within 30 days why such action should not be taken. The NuStar Telephone Company was listed in the appendix, but its Commission identification number was incorrectly listed as 05003300. That number identifies Nustar Communications Corporation.

On August 21, 2002, in accordance with the May 21, 2002 Order, the Commission erroneously revoked Nustar Communications Corporation's authority to operate in Kentucky. Nustar Communications Corporation's operating authority should, therefore, be reactivated and its tariffs reinstated effective August 21, 2002.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Nustar Communications Corporation's operating authority in Kentucky as a telecommunications carrier is hereby reactivated and its tariffs reinstated effective August 21, 2002.

2. As soon as possible, Nustar Communications Corporation shall file copies of its tariffs, setting forth the rates and conditions of service that were in effect on August 21, 2002.
