TO WESTERN KENTUCKY GAS COMPANY

Western Kentucky Gas Company (Western), pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, is requested to file with the Commission the original and 8 copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before September 20, 2002. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. Where information herein has been previously provided, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request.


1. Refer to Item 2 of Western's response to the Commission Staff's data request dated August 9, 2002, which identifies the supplemental information that

Western provided to suppliers subsequent to issuing its April 5, 2002 Request for Proposal ( RFP ).

a. Did every supplier that received the RFP also receive all the supplemental information identified in the response?

b. If no, provide a list of the suppliers to whom Western provided supplemental information and, for each supplier on the list, a list of the information that was supplied.

2. Refer to Item 6 of Western's response to the Commission Staff's data request dated August 9, 2002. Provide a narrative description explaining how the new contract with Woodward Marketing, LLC ( Woodward ) differs from Western's previous contract with Woodward.
