<u>O R D E R</u>

On June 10, 2002, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company (ULH&P) filed with the Commission a proposal to add Rider GP, Green Power Rider, an optional tariff for customers who want to contribute funds for energy generated from environmentally friendly sources. ULH&P did not include in its proposal an effective date for the proposed tariff rider.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further investigation is necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff rider.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed in this proceeding.

2. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately indexed and an original and six copies shall be filed with the Commission and a copy shall be served on all parties.

3. Any requests from the Commission Staff for information shall be responded to as if set forth in a Commission Order. All responses should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Each response shall include the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in the record of this case, reference may be made to the specific location of the information in responding to the request.

4. ULH&P shall give notice of any hearing in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5). At the time publication is requested, ULH&P shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

5. At any public hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimony shall be permitted.

6. Motions for extension of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will granted only upon a showing of good cause.

7. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.

1. Explain in detail why ULH&P believes it may not be able to purchase green power for those customers requesting such power.

2. Is ULH&P aware of a green power tariff recently enacted by East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc., which provides for the purchase of green power in discrete blocks for customers willing to pay a premium for such power? Explain why ULH&P would be unable to purchase green power under similar terms for its customers.

3. Explain ULH&P s efforts to coordinate green power purchases with either affiliated utilities or non-affiliated utilities.

4. Does the Cincinnati Gas and Electric Company or PSI Energy, Inc. have green power tariffs? If yes, provide copies of the tariffs and any reports or analyses discussing the programs.
