

FIRST DATA REQUEST OF COMMISSION STAFF
TO KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY

Kentucky Utilities Company (KU), pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, is requested to file with the Commission the original and 8 copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within 10 days of the date of this request. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. Where information herein has been previously provided, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request.

1. Refer to Appendix F, Testimony of Ronald L. Willhite, page 6, lines 4 and 5. The response states that KU will connect customers to facilities outside the 1973 city limit area at a minimal cost.

- a. Who will bear the cost?
 - b. Provide an estimate of the cost.
2. Refer to the Application, page 4, section V. According to this section, the parties will need to obtain FERC approval of an Amendment to the parties 1967 Interchange Agreement and a Facilities Lease Agreement in connection with such transfer. What is the status of the approval?
 3. Provide the original cost and the accumulated depreciation as stated on the books of KU for the assets to be transferred from KU to the city of Paris.
 4. Refer to page 4 of the Testimony of Robert Casher. Provide a copy of the bill comparison prepared by W. M. Lewis and Associates.
 5. For KU and the city of Paris, provide the number of customers for each rate class and include the average usage per rate class.
 6. Will the city of Paris adopt the KU tariff that is currently filed with the Commission?
 7. What steps will the city of Paris take to ensure a smooth transition for KU customers?
