<u>O R D E R</u>

On August 12, 2002, Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson") filed a tariff proposal to add water-pumping services. Grayson proposed that the tariff become effective on September 5, 2002.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further investigation is needed to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariff filing of Grayson is suspended for five months from September 5, 2002 up to and including February 4, 2003.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
