FIRST DATA REQUEST OF COMMISSION STAFF
TO THE UNION LIGHT, HEAT AND POWER COMPANY

The Union Light, Heat and Power Company (ULH&P), pursuant to Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, is requested to file with the Commission the original and 5 copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due October 31, 2002. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. Where information herein has been previously provided, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request.

1. Concerning the contract between ULH&P and Cinergy Marketing & Trading (CM&T):

a. Provide a copy of the contract.

b. Identify and explain any provision in this contract that allows the commodity price and/or the reservation fee to be changed during the term of the contract.

2. Identify the suppliers selected to provide gas to ULH&P and indicate the percentage of ULH&P's total gas needs that each is providing.


3. Concerning the management of ULH&P's gas portfolio:

a. Does ULH&P intend to utilize the services of an asset manager?

b. If yes, identify the provider of asset management services. Indicate if the asset manager is an associated or affiliated company with ULH&P. Provide all the details of the business relationship between the asset manager and ULH&P.

c. Describe the involvement of the asset manager in the selection of the gas suppliers responding to the July 12, 2002 solicitation.

d. Indicate if the asset manager is associated or affiliated with any of the respondents to the July 12, 2002 solicitation.
