STAFF REPORT

ON

CHIMNEY ROCK WASTE MANAGEMENT, LLC

CASE NO. 2002-00376

Pursuant to a request of Chimney Rock Waste Management, LLC (Chimney Rock) for assistance in establishing an initial tariff, Commission Staff (Staff) performed a limited financial review of Chimney Rock's test year operations, the twelve months ended December 31, 2001. The scope of Staff's review was limited to obtaining information as to whether test period operations were representative of a normal year. Insignificant or immaterial discrepancies were not pursued and are not addressed herein.

Upon completion of the review, Staff assisted Chimney Rock in the development and preparation of an application. The application included a statement of expenses and a revenue requirement determination. Annual expenses for the test year totaled \$13,979. The revenue requirement was determined to be \$15,885 by applying the 88 percent operating ratio method. The Commission generally utilizes this method when setting rates for small investor owned utilities. The rates were then determined to be \$40.42 per month for the 18 single-family residential dwelling customers and \$596.21 per month for the Chimney Rock RV Park.

On October 10, 2002, Chimney Rock submitted the rate application to the Commission for consideration. Staff is hereby adopting the contents of that application as its recommendation in this report as if fully set out herein. Staff further recommends that the Commission not suspend the proposed rates and allow the rates to go into

effect on November 14, 2002, as requested by Chimney Rock. Chimney Rock

continues to incur daily operating expense without receiving revenue. Staff has

performed all necessary review to determine the proposed rates reasonable. To delay

Chimney Rock collection of revenue could materially impair or damage its credit and

operations and would serve only to increase the expenses of Chimney Rock through

otherwise unnecessary litigation expense which would ultimately be borne by its

ratepayers.

Sam Reid is responsible for all revenue adjustments and calculation of the

proposed rates. Scott Lawless is responsible for the determination of the revenue

requirement. Based on the information reviewed, Staff is of the opinion that the rates

proposed by Chimney Rock, as shown in Attachment A of this report, are reasonable

and should be approved by this Commission.
