
Should documents of any kind be filed with the Commission in the course of this proceeding, the documents shall also be served on all parties of record.

I am writing in behave of myself and other Bell South customers who live outside the base rate area or city limits who are still paying mileage charges to this company for private telephone lines.

I am amazed that BellSouth is still allowed to charge mileage fees to these customers as these charges were originally set for private lines in rural areas when party lines where the norm outside the base rate area.

I know that most local telephone companies stopped charging mileage fees when party lines were totally replaced by private lines in all areas back in the late 1980's and early 1990's in Kentucky and many other states in the United States.

I am having no luck at all talking to BellSouth on this issue. I feel my only option is to request from you that these charges are dropped immediately and the customers are given a refund check from BellSouth equal to at least 10 to 15 years of mileage charges.

We pay \$5.20 each and every month in mileage charges for our private line and have since we purchased our home on Hawthorne Lane in Anderson County.

Please, take every step you can to have these charges dropped and refund checks sent out to the customers who are still being billed mileage as when you investigate this request I think you will find that I am correct about the other local telephone companies dropping this fee many years ago.

Why is BellSouth the only large company that I am aware of still able to charge this fee?

Please let me know just as soon as possible. I feel this is an example of a large company taking money from the pockets of Kentucky citizens. My family for one, could certainly put to use this \$5.20 every month in many many other ways.
