O R D E R

On January 3, 2003, Crown Communication Inc. and Westal-Milwaukee Company, LLC, d/b/a Cingular Wireless - Owensboro (collectively Cingular ) requested that the Commission withdraw the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued on May 15, 2002, authorizing the construction by Cingular of a wireless communication facility. No parties intervened in this proceeding, and the local planning commission has been notified of Cingulars decision to forego construction of the authorized facility.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Cingular on May 15, 2002 is revoked.

2. The information requested from Cingular by the Commission's May 15, 2002 Order is no longer required.

3. This case is closed and is removed from the Commission's docket.
