<u>ORDER</u>

Kentucky Rural Water Association (KRWA) has applied for accreditation for training sessions for water district commissioners held on January 21, 2003 in Morehead, Kentucky; on January 23, 2003 in Draffenville, Kentucky; and on January 30, 2003, in Hartford, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner s understanding of his or her duties. These sessions for which approval is sought include instruction regarding <u>inter alia</u>, trends in applicable law and regulations, water treatment, and utility management, finance, and administration. Having reviewed the KRWA's application describing the sessions, the Commission finds that each of these sessions will enhance a water district commissioner and board member's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's regional meetings conducted at Draffenville, Kentucky on January 23, 2003; at Morehead, Kentucky on January 21, 2003; and at Hartford, Kentucky on January 30, 2003 are each approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of the date of this Order, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA s application, a description of those changes.
