O R D E R

On October 30, 2003, Peaks Mill Water District (Peaks Mill) filed a petition requesting rehearing and modification of the Commission s final Order in this case. Specifically, Peaks Mill asks the Commission to reconsider the Order to the extent that it requires Peaks Mill to provide service to Complainants rental property in Owen County. As grounds for its petition, Peaks Mill states that the rental property may, in fact, currently receive water from the Kentucky-American Water Company (Kentucky-American). It alleges that it has been advised by Kentucky-American that Complainants have paid for, and been supplied, water. Under these circumstances, Peaks Mill contends, its own installation of facilities at the same location would be duplicative and wasteful.

Complainants have filed no response to the petition.

Based on the information filed by Peaks Mill, the Commission concludes that if, in fact, Kentucky-American currently supplies service to the Complainants rental property, Peaks Mill should not be required to serve.

The Commission being sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Peaks Mill's motion is granted to the extent that the final Order is modified to provide that Peaks Mill need not serve Complainant's rental property if service is already being provided by Kentucky-American.
