O R D E R

On May 14, 2003, Carroll County Water District #1 ( Carroll County ) filed with the Commission proposed revisions to its tariff. The application proposed to revise language and increase certain non-recurring charges. The Commission suspended the proposed rates on May 21, 2003, and on May 23, 2003, issued a letter asking Carroll County for revisions to its proposed tariff. On June 10, 2003 and August 2, 2003, Carroll County submitted the requested revisions to its proposed tariff. Carroll County has provided adequate evidence of the individual expenses incurred to provide the services associated with the proposed charges.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. The proposed charges are equal to the expenses incurred to provide the associated services.
2. The charges and policies set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The charges in the Appendix are approved for services rendered on and after the date of this Order.

2. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Carroll County shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets showing an effective date of the date of this Order.
