O R D E R

On May 15, 2003, South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ( South Kentucky ) filed revised tariffs adding new lighting offerings and new options for various types of poles to support the lighting fixtures. The revised tariffs, including rates for the new lights and poles, contained a proposed effective date of June 1, 2003. Since KRS 278.180 requires a minimum notice of 30 days for tariff revisions, the earliest the revised tariffs could become effective is June 14, 2003. By Order dated May 28, 2003, the Commission suspended the proposed tariffs for 5 months from June 14, 2003 up to and including November 13, 2003.

The revised tariffs include rates for new metal halide lights on Schedule OL - Outdoor Lighting Service, Security Lights and new metal halide and mercury vapor lights and new decorative poles on Schedule DSTL - Decorative Street Lighting.

Based on its review of the tariffs and the testimony and cost justification filed in support thereof, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff revisions are reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. South Kentucky's proposed revisions to its Outdoor Lighting Service, Security Lights and Decorative Street Lighting tariffs are approved effective on and after the date of this Order.

2. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, South Kentucky shall file its revised Outdoor Lighting Service, Security Lights and Decorative Street Lighting tariffs showing the date issued, the effective date, and that they were issued by authority of this Order.
