<u>ORDER</u>

On August 1, 2003, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District (Western Lewis) applied for authority to revise certain non-recurring charges in both its water and gas utilities. Western Lewis was notified on August 7, 2003 that the filing was deficient. On August 15, 2003, Western Lewis filed information that cured the deficiencies and the application was considered filed as of that date.

In addition to the revised non-recurring charges, Western Lewis seeks to change its late payment policy and add a bulk water charge for the water division. The bulk water charge of \$5.50 per 1,000 gallons is not considered a non-recurring charge as defined in 807 KAR 5:006, Section 8, and therefore cannot be approved in this case.

Western Lewis requests that the date on which the late payment penalty of 10 percent is assessed be changed from the 25th of the month to the 15th of the month. This change will make the date that the late payment penalty is assessed the same for both the water and gas divisions.

Western Lewis has provided adequate evidence of the individual expenses incurred to provide the services associated with the proposed charges.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. The proposed non-recurring charges are equal to the expenses incurred to provide the associated services.

2. The bulk water charge of \$5.50 per 1,000 gallons is not considered a nonrecurring charge as defined in 807 KAR 5:006, Section 8, and should be denied.

3. The non-recurring charges and policies set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The non-recurring charges and policies in the Appendix are approved for services rendered on and after the date of this Order.

2. The bulk water charge of \$5.50 per 1,000 gallons is denied.

3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Western Lewis shall file with the

Commission revised tariff sheets showing the charges and policies approved herein.
