## ORDER

On July 22, 2004, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") jointly filed a motion requesting an informal conference to be held on July 27, 2004 for the purpose of discussing a procedural schedule regarding the issues set forth in the Commission's July 15, 2004 Order. The Commission notes that it has already established, by Order dated July 22, 2004, an informal conference to be held on August 4, 2004 for that purpose. Therefore, the Commission will deny the joint motion as moot. However, in the event that LG&E and KU and all other parties are agreeable to participate either in person or by telephone in an informal conference on a mutually agreeable date prior to August 4, 2004, LG&E and KU should formally notify the Commission.

Further, the Commission finds that the evidentiary records of these cases were reopened by our July 15, 2004 Order to allow the parties to address the allegations raised by the Office of the Attorney General ("AG") that LG&E and KU may have had

improper ex parte contacts with Commission employees and that the settlement

negotiations that resulted in the Partial Settlement Agreement, Stipulation and

Recommendation may have been the product of collusion. Since it was the AG that

raised these allegations, the AG bears the burden of proof and will be expected to

propose a procedural schedule at the August 4, 2004 informal conference. In the event

the AG fails to appear and propose a procedural schedule, the Commission may

dismiss these issues and close the evidentiary record with regard to these allegations

without further proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the joint motion filed by LG&E and KU for an

informal conference is denied as moot.
