ORDER

On February 17, 2004, Robert Keith Campbell (“Complainant”) filed with the Commission a formal complaint against Fleming-Mason Energy Cooperative (“Fleming-Mason”), alleging that employees and/or contractors of Fleming-Mason, while clearing growth from power lines on his property, left debris and garbage behind, thus inhibiting the use of his property. On May 12, 2004, David White of Commission Staff met with Complainant and representatives from Fleming-Mason at Complainant’s property to investigate Fleming-Mason’s efforts to satisfy the complaint. Mr. White’s investigation report, filed on May 17, 2004, indicated that Fleming-Mason had addressed many, if not all, of Complainant’s concerns.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within 15 days of the date of this Order, Complainant shall file any objections he may have to Fleming-Mason’s proposed satisfaction.

2. If no filings from Complainant are received within 15 days of the date of this Order, this complaint shall be dismissed as satisfied and removed from the Commission's active docket without further Order of the Commission.
