O R D E R

On June 16, 2004, Cingular Wireless (“Cingular”) filed with the Commission a motion, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, Section 12(5), requesting a 10-day extension of time in which to satisfy or answer Roy Miller’s complaint. As grounds for its motion, Cingular claims that it was not served with the Commission’s May 11, 2004 Order until June 3, 2004, and that it requires additional time in which to conduct its investigation. Cingular also states that it would like the opportunity to attempt to resolve the complaint prior to filing its answer.

The Commission finds that good cause exists to grant Cingular’s motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Cingular shall have 10 days from the date of this Order in which to file its answer to Mr. Miller’s complaint.
