O R D E R

On July 6, 2004, Cingular Wireless (“Cingular”) filed with the Commission a document purporting to satisfy the matter of which Complainant complained. On July 16, 2004, in response to a voice mail from Complainant, Commission Staff contacted Complainant. Complainant voiced his dissatisfaction with the proposed settlement, and Commission Staff informed Complainant that all such protestations must be made in writing and filed with the Commission, with copies served on all parties. As of the date of this Order, no objections to the proposed satisfaction have been filed with the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within 15 days of the date of this Order, Complainant shall file any objections he may have to Cingular’s proposed satisfaction.
2. If no filings from Complainant are received within 15 days of the date of this Order, this complaint shall be dismissed as satisfied and removed from the Commission’s active docket without further Order of the Commission.
