O R D E R

On September 2, 2004, Interstate Natural Gas Company ("Interstate") filed a proposed tariff setting forth its rates, rules, and regulations to operate as a farm tap system. Interstate proposed that the tariff become effective on September 31, 2004.¹ The Commission finds that, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:026, the proposal cannot become effective until 60 days' notice has been given to the Commission; therefore, the earliest date the tariff proposal could become effective is November 1, 2004. The Commission further finds that additional proceedings are necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that such proceedings cannot be concluded by November 1, 2004.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This proceeding is established to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.
2. The proposed rates are suspended for 5 months from November 1, 2004 up to and including March 31, 2005.

¹ Interstate proposed an effective date of "September 31, 2004." It is assumed that Interstate intended the rate to become effective on the last day of September.

3. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
