## ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of its Green River Regional Meeting, held July 15, 2004 in Knottsville, Kentucky; its Northeast Regional Meeting, held July 20, 2004 in Morehead, Kentucky; and its Western Regional Meeting, held July 22, 2004 in Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The meetings for which approval is sought included instruction regarding proposed modifications to Kentucky Division of Water administrative regulations, their implications and public relations. Having reviewed KRWA's application describing the proposed courses, the Commission finds that the proposed courses will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours of water district management training per each meeting.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Each of KRWA's proposed courses of instruction are hereby approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course

of instruction.

3. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, KRWA shall file with the

Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved courses of instruction were

performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after

KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
