O R D E R

On November 11, 2004, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") filed a letter with the Commission requesting permission to withdraw its application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to qualify it to bid on a gas franchise in the city of Pleasureville, Kentucky. The Commission, having considered the letter as a motion, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that the motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. LG&E's motion to withdraw its application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to qualify it to bid on a gas franchise in the city of Pleasureville, Kentucky is granted.

2. This case is closed and is removed from the Commission's docket.
