<u>ORDER</u>

On September 14, 2004, SouthEast Telephone, Inc. ("SouthEast") filed a motion "to hold in abeyance" the October 8, 2004 deadline to renegotiate its existing interconnection agreement with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"). SouthEast asserted that this deadline should be "held in abeyance" due to actions taken by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC").

On September 24, 2004, BellSouth responded to this motion contending that the Commission need not grant SouthEast's request. The current contract between BellSouth and SouthEast, according to BellSouth, will continue on a month-to-month basis after its expiration. Moreover, negotiations between the parties continue.

The Commission has received no filings in this matter since September 2004. On information and belief, it appears that this particular petition may be moot because of subsequent action by the FCC. Moreover, matters pertaining to carrier obligations are pending in Case No. 2004-00427.¹
