ORDER

Crown Communication Inc. and BellSouth Personal Communications, LLC (“Applicants”) have moved for corrections in the Commission’s Order of August 6, 2004. In support of their motion, Applicants assert that, through inadvertence or oversight, the Commission incorrectly stated the coordinates for the proposed wireless communications facility.

Included in the Applicants’ application was a Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) application that contained coordinates for the proposed facility. The Commission, when granting Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity for wireless communications facilities, bases its final action on the coordinates that are filed with the FAA. Having reviewed the record of this proceeding, we find that our Order of August 6, 2004 contained the coordinates listed in the FAA application and, therefore, adequately reflected the location of the tower. If Applicants wish to revise the coordinates for this wireless facility, they should amend their application and submit

supporting evidence to indicate that the revised coordinates have been listed in all necessary documents filed with the FAA.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicants' motion to correct errors is denied.
