ORDER

On December 22, 2005, in Case No. 2005-00042,¹ the Commission approved rates for The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with ULH&P's gas cost adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On February 10, 2006, ULH&P filed its GCA to be effective March 2, 2006. ULH&P previously obtained Commission approval to file its GCA within 20 days of the proposed effective date.²

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. ULH&P's notice includes rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
- 2. ULH&P's Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") is \$8.948 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$1.36 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$10.308.

3. ULH&P's notice sets out no current refund adjustment ("RA"). ULH&P's

notice sets out a total RA of (.6) cent per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total

RA.

4. ULH&P's notice sets out a current quarter actual adjustment ("AA") of 87.3

cents per Mcf. ULH&P's notice sets out a total AA of 51 cents per Mcf, which is an

increase of 51.1 cents per Mcf from its previous total AA.

5. ULH&P's notice sets out a current quarter balancing adjustment ("BA") of

(.4) cent per Mcf. ULH&P's notice sets out a total BA of 3.5 cents per Mcf, which is no

change from its previous total BA.

6. ULH&P's gas cost recovery rate ("GCR") is \$9.487 per Mcf, which is a

decrease of 84.9 cents per Mcf from its previous GCR of \$10.336.

7. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and

should be approved for final meter readings by ULH&P on and after March 2, 2006.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter

readings on and after March 2, 2006.

2. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, ULH&P shall file with this

Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
