ORDER

On July 18, 2007, the parties to this case, Brandenburg Telephone Company (“Brandenburg Telephone”) and Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. (“Global Crossing”) participated with Commission Staff in an informal conference at the Commission’s offices. At the conclusion of the conference, the parties and Commission Staff agreed that the Commission would issue an Order requiring the parties to inform the Commission of the status of settlement negotiations between the two parties and, if no settlement was reached, requiring Global Crossing to answer Brandenburg Telephone’s complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, the parties, either jointly or separately, shall inform the Commission of the status of settlement negotiations.

2. Within 15 days of the date of this Order, should the parties inform the Commission that settlement cannot be reached, Global Crossing shall file its answer to Brandenburg Telephone's complaint.
