O R D E R

Pursuant to KRS 100.324(1),¹the Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Notice is given to the planning commissions of Fayette, Franklin, Owen, and Scott counties, Kentucky, that the Commission will conduct a hearing in the above-styled matter on November 26, 2007, to consider Kentucky-American Water Company's application to construct certain water treatment and transmission facilities in these counties. Any planning commission may submit written comments to the Commission regarding these proposed facilities or may request intervention in these proceedings.

¹ All other provisions of this chapter to the contrary notwithstanding, public utilities operating under the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission, except as specified in KRS 100.987, or the Department of Vehicle Regulation or Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, any municipally owned electric system, and common carriers by rail shall not be required to receive the approval of the planning unit for the location or relocation of any of their service facilities. Service facilities include all facilities of such utilities and common carriers by rail other than office space, garage space, and warehouse space and include office space, garage space, and warehouse space when such space is incidental to a service facility. The Public Service Commission and the Department of Vehicle Regulation shall give notice to the planning commission of any planning unit of any hearing which affects locations or relocations of service facilities within that planning unit's jurisdiction.

2. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this Order upon all planning commissions located in Fayette, Franklin, Owen, and Scott counties, Kentucky.
