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#### ORDER

On May 4, 2007, Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") filed a notice of intent to file an application for approval of the construction of a 161 kV transmission line in Ohio County, Kentucky. The application was filed with the Commission on July 2, 2007. According to the application, the route for the proposed line begins at Big Rivers' Wilson Power Plant site, approximately 6 miles west of Centertown in western Ohio County, and extends 13 miles to the southeast to an existing Big Rivers 161 kV transmission line located approximately 3 miles southeast of McHenry in southern Ohio County. Big Rivers notes that this proposed route is the same as a portion of the route selected by East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("East Kentucky") for its transmission line project for which the Commission granted it a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity<sup>1</sup> in Case No. 2005-00207.<sup>2</sup>

Big Rivers states that the Ohio County line is necessary in order to have the ability to export 850 MW of excess generating capacity outside its transmission system in the event that two large aluminum smelters currently served by Big Rivers opt to terminate their service contracts. Such termination, if it occurs, would be contingent upon Commission approval of Big Rivers' proposal to unwind the various agreements between and among Big Rivers and E.ON U.S., LLC ("E.ON"), in place since 1998, that gave the E.ON parties operational control of power plants owned or operated by Big Rivers and ownership of the electricity generated by them. Big Rivers states that "should the Unwind Transaction not go forward, the proposed project will not be necessary at this time," and, therefore, proposes that approval of its application be "made contingent upon, and effective concurrently with, approval of the Unwind Transaction."

Pursuant to KRS 278.020(8), "The commission shall issue its decision no later than ninety (90) days after the application is filed, unless the commission extends this period for good cause, to one hundred twenty (120) days." Due to the nature of the case and the issues involved, the Commission finds that good cause exists in this matter to warrant such an extension.

In the exercise of its discretion pursuant to KRS 278.020(8), the Commission does not deem it necessary in the present case to hire an independent firm to assist it in reaching its decision. Therefore, the Commission has no plans to retain the services of a staff consultant to review the application, pursuant to KRS 278.020(8) and KRS 278.255(3).

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Using the 120-day schedule, the Commission now issues a preliminary procedural Order, attached hereto.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The time period in which the Commission must issue its decision in this case is extended to 120 days.

The procedural schedule attached to this Order as Appendix A shall apply.
